Dean College offers the Associate of Arts (AA) degree, as well as the Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree.

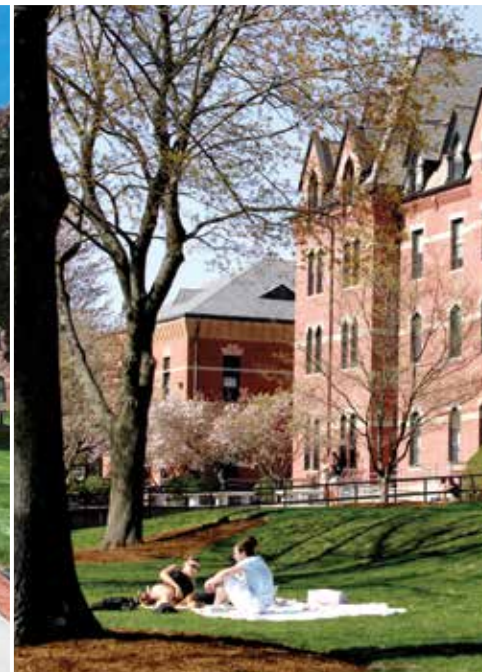
### Campus

Dean College's campus is situated on 100 acres and includes 13 academic buildings, 12 residential buildings and 2 athletic fields. Two of the buildings are currently listed on the US National Register of Historic Places. Over the past 3 years, the campus center has been

expanded and now includes new dining center facilities, fitness center, center for advising and career planning, and main stage theater.

### Dining
