## Academics

Within a rigorous preparatory course of study, Marianapolis Prep nurtures students to become responsible and independent learners. Each student is supported by his or her advisor, who monitors progress and acts as a resource throughout the school year. With a variety of programs in the arts, students have room to master their craft at Marianapolis, whether in The Blackbox Theatre, the dance studio, or in the visual arts classrooms.

## Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

13 available including: Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Spanish, U.S. History, World History, European History, Psychology, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.

## ESL Program

The ESL department offers a range of courses for students needing to strengthen their skills in the four modalities; Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing, with the goal of being well prepared for entry to a U.S. University. Classroom learning is supported by the "Experiential Learning Program" where students choose from a variety of excursions designed to enrich language learning while building cultural competence.

## Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

## Campus Life

The residential program at Marianapolis Prep integrates the comfort of home-style living into the structure of a boarding school schedule. There are 6 dormitories on campus, separated by gender as 2 for boys and 4 for girls. Rooms are comprised of either 2, 3 or 4 students, and House Parents live within each of the dormitories to look after the students' needs. Each dormitory also contains common space for students to socialize.

## Activities

Students are exposed to a number of opportunities, including extracurricular activities, cultural trips abroad, the chance to hold leadership positions, and L.E.A.P. Week. All students are encouraged to explore their interests outside of the classroom in some of the more than 30 clubs and organizations offered on campus. Some clubs include Community Choir, Model UN, Photography Club, Robotics & Engineering Club, Ski Club, and Gymnastics.

## Sports
