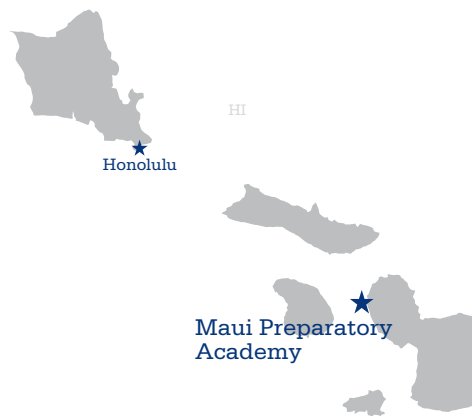

### Academics

Maui Preparatory Academy nurtures academic excellence, artistic expression, and athletic achievement, and challenges its students to think critically, to give of themselves generously, to collaborate honestly and selflessly, and to commit to improving the world. In addition to college preparatory and Advanced Placement courses, Maui Prep offers a range of course options, including Marine Science, Japanese and various art and music courses.

### Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

9 available including: English Language & Composition, Literature & Composition, Calculus AB, United States History, Art History, European History, Biology, Physics B, and Studio Art.

### ESL Program

Maui Prep provides an ESL/Language Lab for students who are still developing their English skills, while matriculating into all mainstream courses.

### Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

### Campus Life

The residential facility at Maui Prep is located 2.7 miles (7 minute drive) from the main academic campus. Three to four students reside in each apartment, which is fully equipped with bathroom and kitchenette, and is ideal for student apartment-style living. Full time Dorm Parents and Residential staff also reside in the building, which is safe and secure with private gate and has private access to a local beach. Lounge areas are available on the first floor where students can gather, and shuttle access is provided each morning and afternoon to accommodate student activities.

### Activities

Students are invited to participate in interscholastic athletics, various clubs and organizations, and community service, among other programs. All Upper School students are required to complete 25 community service hours per academic year, as well as participating in two seasons of sports each year. There are also several clubs and organizations on campus for students to join.

### Sports

All Upper School students are required to participate in two seasons of Maui Interscholastic League sports each school year. Interscholastic sports teams include: Cross Country, Golf, Paddling, Swimming, Surfing, Tennis, Track & Field, and Volleyball. Premier Academies in Tennis and Golf are also available to Boarding students.
