Academics

Olney Friends School offers a comprehensive, intellectually challenging college preparatory curriculum that promotes creativity and curiosity both inside the classroom and out. The integrated humanities curriculum was designed with a recognition of the relationship that exists between literature, history, and religion. With the renovation of the new Stillwater Science Center, Olney Friends places a strong emphasis on the growing fields of STEM, offering numerous courses in the sciences. Olney Friends School is also an SAT Testing site for exams in October and May.

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

Although AP courses aren't offered, all students are welcome to participate in AP exams at the end of the academic year.

ESL Program

Olney Friends School offers ESL support for students with an intermediate level of English.

Success Rate

100% of students are accepted to a 4 year college or university.

Campus Life

Olney Friends School has two dormitories on campus: one for boys and one for girls, staffed with 3-4 adult faculty. All students are involved in co-curricular activities on campus, including community service, student government, physical education and help with campus facilities.

Students are encouraged to be involved in all aspects of the school and community life, including athletics, community service and extra-curricular activities. Leadership opportunities are also available in organizations such as: Admissions Ambassadors, Big Brother/Big Sister, Self Government, Spiritual Life Committee, Student Dorm Staff, and Tech Crew.
