Special Features

Fisher College is a non-profit educational institution approved by the Higher Education of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and authorized to grant the degrees of Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, Associate in Science, and Associate in Arts. The Academic Center for Enrichment is staffed with 15-20 professional tutors available to assist students with organizational and study skills, the learning process and academic intervention.

Pathway Program

Fisher College offers a Pathway Program for international first year students, which provides an opportunity for academic study in classes specifically designed to help students succeed at an American college.
